Seriously, how many Billy Bob Joe Penny's do you know?

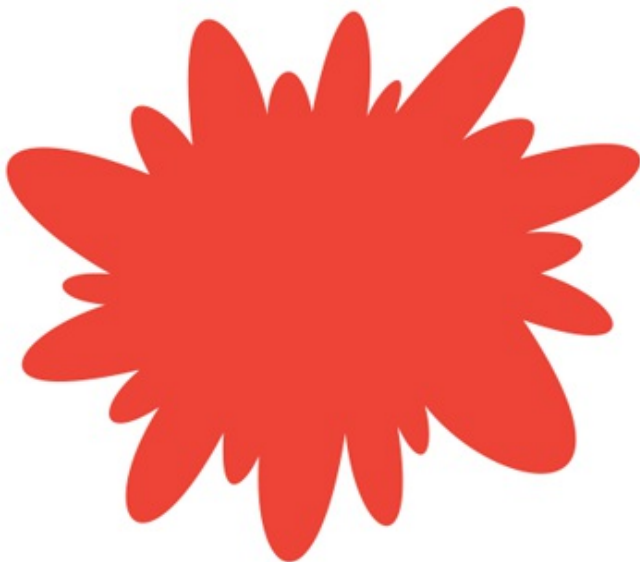

I've Benjamin on my guitar all day!

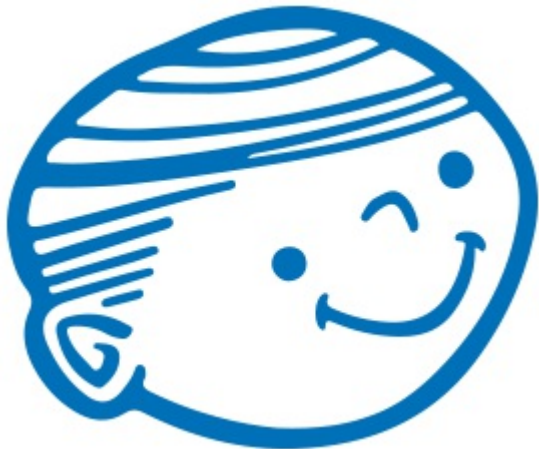
